Agenda:

1. Review of outstanding actions:

- Michael and Sumanth to speak to other people to get information on deployment and use of DDDS.

Sumanth has started a dialog with Peter Koch, but it is still ongoing. We should probably send him a proposal based on what we have. Scott will send relevant text from v12 to Sumanth as a basis for this. Noted that we will need at least on I-D (or RFC?) for expert review to get the new item registered.

The proposed I-D will catalyse the discussion, so there is no need to keep this action.
CLOSED.

- Michael to propose text on self-signed certs for UA.

Ongoing.

- Sumanth to propose text on PKI-based certs for UA.

Ongoing.

- Scott to prepare some initial slides and send them to the list for review.
CLOSED.

- Scott to start threads on remaining issues.

Ongoing. Some done - a further batch to be done today, depending on outcome of agenda item 3.

- All to review v12.

Ongoing. Cut-off for changes to be included in v13 is Wednesday.

- Scott and Michael to write an I-D to register the new tag with IANA.

Ongoing. Some discussions held, and should have first cut soon.

- Michael to supply reference to resolve ambiguity with obtaining a URI from NAPTR.

Done and acceptable to Scott. CLOSED.

2. Feedback from SIPit

Scott presented his slides to a very full room at SIPit. This seemed to be a very good way of passing standardisation information to the implementer community, and it would be beneficial for other topics too. Scott will suggest to Robert that he should advertise this in his SIPit report to relevant IETF groups. Marc will bring it up at next board meeting. Thanks to Scott for the initial idea and for following it through.

Points raised during the discussion at SIPit:

- Security concerns about username/password being logged in log files, as result of these being in the Request-URI.

- Question on cert boot problem. Scott needs to chase up the person concerned to clarify the question.

** Action Scott.

- Need a good description of when/how to back-off (already noted as open issue 2).

- Question whether ITAD registry is the right solution. Scott will try to get the person concerned to join the next call (but see also issues 3/4 below).

** Action Scott.

3. Review of open issues

Issue 1 - question whether we need to keep 2.1.1.2 on VLAN/Diffserv. Rifaat wants to keep it, so will provide some better text.

** Action Rifaat.

Issue 2 - Need some text on when/how to back-off. John will follow this up with Sumanth, who may be able to extract something from config-framework.

** Action John.

Issues 3/4 - Instead of ITAD, could extend the proposed I-D to cover derivation of URI from a number using NAPTR. Scott to post a note to the list.

** Action Scott.

Issues 5/6 - no objections to removal of 3.2 and 3.3 as we are not specifying data formats. Scott to post note to seek confirmation.

** Action Scott.

Issues 7/8 - How do we do reset to default using NOTIFY? Consensus seemed to be to do it as a data item. Scott to propose text.

** Action Scott.

4. Next steps

Scott hopes to get confirmation of resolution of some of the above issues in the next couple days, and then will produce v13.

** Action Scott.

Anything for inclusion in v13 should be posted to the list by Wednesday.
