Addressing the Problems

The SIP Forum, Fax over IP (FoIP) Task Group has published its formal Problem Statement, which may be viewed on the SIP Forum Web site, www.sipforum.org. The next phase of work for the Task Group is to address each problem in turn in order to come up with appropriate resolutions or recommendations on how best to mitigate the difficulties.

Since the participating group is limited in number it has been decided that it is best for all participants to be involved in discussions on all issues. To facilitate this, the group has decided to limit the number of issues being tackled at a time to a number that allows the group as a whole to participate in each.

To address each of the identified problems, it is the task groups plan to

1. Chose the next issue to be tackled.
2. Canvas for volunteers to chair the work on the topic.
3. Discuss the problem and potential resolutions on the mailing list and at the scheduled meetings
4. Document the final decisions and/or recommendations for approval of the task group.

It is the responsibility of the Chair of the work topic to instigate the work of the group in this area and to document the issues, resolutions and recommendations as appropriate.

Final decisions on each topic will be taken by the task group as a whole on a consensus basis.

If, in the judgment of the SIP Forum FoIP Task Group, existing IETF and or ITU standards need to be modified, the working group will develop a recommendation to the appropriate Standards Development Organization (SDO) on what has been discovered and recommend appropriate action by the SDO to remedy the issue.
