


### SHAKEN IMPLEMENTATION STATUS

- ► Service Providers:
  - ▶ 344 SPs authorized
  - Mix of Large, medium and small SPs, urban and rural, wireline, wireless and interconnected VolP
- Certification Authorities:
  - 9 CAs approved
  - 7 serving the broader industry
  - ▶ PMA continues to review Certification Practice Statements

#### FUNDING METHODOLOGY

- ▶ SHAKEN Framework Budget
  - ▶ STI-GA, STI-PA, Contingency Fund for other costs, such as Change Orders
- ▶ 2021 funding 100% via STI-PA Fees
  - ► Minimum \$825
  - Maximum \$283,950
  - ▶ 2021 Contribution Factor: .0001821
  - ▶ Shaken Framework fully funded for 2021
- ▶ 2022 funding 100% via STI-PA Fees
  - Contribution Factor: TBD



#### UPCOMING POLICY CHANGES

- Resp Org Access to SPC tokens
  - ▶ STI-GA Board voted to change policies necessary for Non-SP Resp Orgs to attain access to SPC tokens.
- Delegated Certificates
  - ► STI-GA Board voted to change policies necessary for the optional use delegate certificates in the SHAKEN ecosystem



#### SPC TOKEN ACCESS POLICY

- Board's goal is to open SPC token access to as many service providers as possible while ensuring continued integrity and security of ecosystem
- Changed criteria
  - Have a current 499A on file with the FCC
  - Have been assigned and Operating Company Number
  - ► Have certified with the FCC that they have implemented STIR/SHAKEN or comply with the Robocall Mitigation Program requirements and are listed in the FCC database
  - Any SPs previously authorized under the direct access to TN criteria must meet the new criteria by July 30, 2021 or risk SPC token revocation.



### SPC TOKEN ACCESS POLICY CONT'D

- Changed criteria for to allow Resp Orgs access
  - ► Have a current form 499A on file with the FCC, or can provide proof of payment of Annual Resp Org Fee to the FCC
  - Have been assigned an Operating Company Number (OCN), or a Resp Org ID
  - ► Have certified with the FCC that they have implemented STIR/SHAKEN or comply with the Robocall Mitigation Program requirements and are listed in the FCC database; or is a non-service provider Resp Org that has direct access to telephone numbers from the Toll-Free Number Administrator (TFNA).



#### REVOCATION & REINSTATEMENT POLICIES

- Revocation
  - Board process to withdraw SPC token access from a provider found to be abusing their SPC token access privileges
  - ▶ SPs must meet revised SPC token Access Policy by July 30, 2021
    - ▶ Notice will be given to non-compliant SPs prior to revocation.
- Reinstatement
  - ▶ A provider may seek reinstatement once their access has been revoked
  - Reinstatement based on provider Plan of Action to remedy issues
- ▶ FCC issued draft order determining its role in SPC token Revocation for decision at August 5, 2021 open meeting.

#### CERTIFICATE POLICY

- Certification Authority practices and policies that must be followed in order to be approved by the STI-PA to serve as trusted STI-CA in the SHAKEN ecosystem
- ▶ Issuance of new CP (version 1.2) due to changes to support optional use of delegate certificates and Resp Org Access to SPC tokens
  - ▶ All current STI-CAs must review new CP, make appropriate edits to their CPS and submit edited CPS for review and approval.



### FUTURE FOCUS OF STI-GA

- ► Ensuring Funding for 2022
- Implementation and testing of
  - Delegate Certificate Functionality
  - Resp Org Access to SPC tokens
- Vetting Qualified Certification Authorities
- Further Evaluation of policy needed to appropriately secure the SHAKEN ecosystem
  - ▶ Methods to identify abuse of the SHAKEN ecosystem
- Continued coordination with the FCC.
  - ► SP Access
  - Revocation and enforcement
- Considering international aspects of STIR/SHAKEN
